2. Charity Quilts is taking on a new look. It has been decided that by combining the needs of all our charities and working on them together it is a more organized way to meet our goals. We are in the process of contacting each of our charities to determine the quantity and sizes of quilts each will need this year.

Responsibilities are being shared by several members: Stefanie is taking over the organization side of charity sewing, overseeing the budget and reporting to the Board; to begin with Joey will be choosing the blocks we'll work on together and she will lead the group on sewing the top; several members have volunteered to take quilts to HCWC monthly; and I will coordinate the process of producing finished quilts to be donated.
