**Standing Committee Reports**

DeStash, Donna Phelps - She said she was really excited that our guest speaker was going to be talking about how to reorganize your quilt space! A great way to get your unused fabrics etc. ready for DeStash. She briefly explained DeStash to our new members and will be sending out a detailed email to everyone. She described some of the sewing machines that are being offered and various other items. Larger donations are tax deductible and Carla has the paperwork for this.

Charity Sewing, Stefanie Voss - Wednesday, 8/13 from 10-3 we will continue sewing poppy blocks for Kerrville flood victims. She reminded members to keep track of volunteer hours as this is critical to HCWC's state and federal funding which is matched to the number of volunteer hours provided. Please remember to turn your Hobbs batting UPC codes to Mary which enables us to purchase a 30' roll of batting for \$100. Four quilts and 78 bags were taken to HCWC this month. We will be returning to regular sewing in September making more of the strip blocks that Mary showed during show and tell.

Poppy Blocks, Pam McGhee - Pam and Cristina made many poppy block kits and these were sewn together during July PHD's. 35 blocks make one quilt top. Quilting provided by Pam, Carla, Kim, Stefanie and Linda H. plus she has provided labels. Pam, Cristina and Karen will drive the quilts to Victoria on the 15th.

Christmas Market, Stefanie Voss - Keep bringing your items to guild meetings so Stefanie and Mary can begin pricing. November 15 is the Market date. Stefanie will send an email describing what is still needed. Also, Cristina will be teaching how to make Ugly Sweater ornaments at the September 24 PHD's for the Market.

Challenge Block, Sally De la Haye - "Easy Does It" block and Sally gave a great tutorial on how to assemble this 9.5 block. The block is due at the October 5 business meeting.

Special Projects, Day 1 Bags, Donna Hector - Donna received a mid-year report from Hunter Beaton, Founder of the organization.
