Christmas Market, Stefanie Voss

Thanks to everyone who helped set up, work the floor, take down and purchase Market items! The Market made \$8094.00 less \$152.06 square fee and \$94.30 sales tax on items purchased at the Tea which was not a tax exempt day. We sold 21 quilts for \$2500.00 and \$5500.00 on all the handmade items. Therefore, our net amount was \$7847.60 half going to support our charitable endeavors and half to support the Guild. The leftover quilts will be donated to Day One bags (8); Barnabas; HCWC - 10 quilts every month.

Stefanie received a round of applause for all her hard work. She and Mary are stepping down from Market coordinators and whoever steps up will be well trained and supported by both of these ladies.
